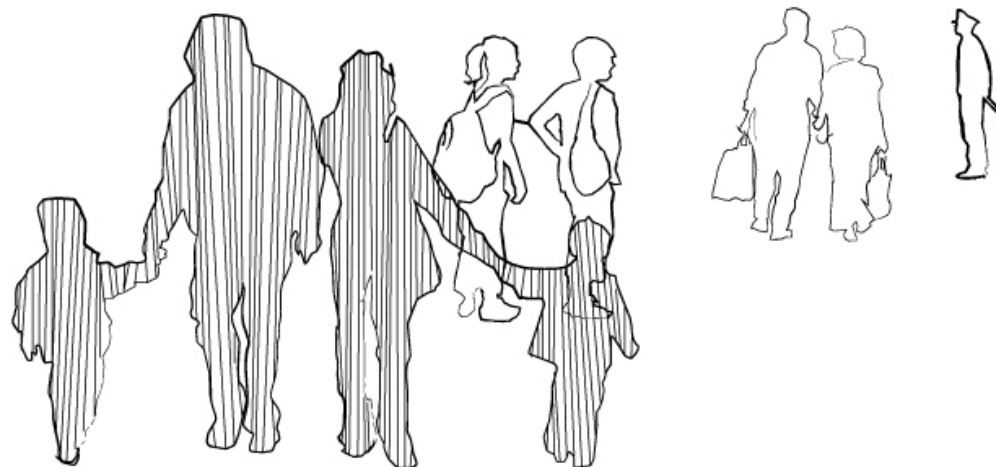

The Champaign-Urbana Immigration Forum is composed of immigrants, students, local clergy, service providers, labor unions representatives and ordinary citizens concerned about the plight of immigrants in our community.

"Secure Communities" is a controversial federal program that engages local police in enforcing immigration laws. Although "Secure Communities" was advertised as an initiative to catch and deport dangerous criminals, it has instead led to the detainment and deportation of many non-criminal immigrants in our community. In fact, locally, over 70% of those arrested and detained are non-criminal immigrant neighbors in Champaign County.

At the forum, speakers will provide context and individuals will give first-hand accounts. Questions and comments are encouraged.
